- CAN-DO will be testing approaches for young adults with cannabis use disorder

Topics like:

What would I do on the Advisory Board?

- Attend virtual meetings on Zoom:
1-2 meetings per year for about 2 years
- In these meetings, advise the study by giving feedback on materials and procedures, discussing findings, and troubleshooting issues
- Earn \$50 for each meeting that you attend

Who can join the Advisory Board?

- You are eligible to join the Advisory Board if you...
 - Are a primary care patient of the Boston Children's Hospital Adolescent/Young Adult Medicine Practice or the Martha Eliot Health Center Adolescent Clinic
 - Are 18-26 years old
 - Have a history of problematic cannabis use
 - Have lots of opinions to share!
